The matches started on Saturday morning at the Cardinal Shooting Center range in Marengo Ohio.



The first day of shooting is metallic sights prone and F-SBR. The conventional course of fire for day one is 160 shots fired over four (4) forty shot matches utilizing 8 target changes. Metallic sights were required. F-SBR shooters use scope for every match.

Match 1 50 Yards:
