

## 2021 Ohio Rifle and Pistol Assn. Adult Smallbore Championship

### **Match Directors Report; June 21, 2021.**

What a great feeling to be on the firing line again and back to normal [mostly], NO MASKS! Lots of warm weather and some fun wind to deal with both days made for a enjoyable State Championship! We had 11 shooters participate in the 2021 state match.

Day 1. Winds were strong and quartering both 10 to 2 o'clock which led to only 3 '400's being shot the whole day all at short range. No 200's were shot at long range this day either. When the day was complete Mr Gideon finished with a 1589-94 for the Iron Sight championship. The Master class winner was Mr. Perry shooting at 1587-101 followed closely by the Expert class winner, Mr. Don Fine with a 1587-96.

After firing was completed as has become tradition we headed out as a group to the Legacy for a meal. 14 friends enjoying and catching up on things since our last shoot together, a great time.

Day 2. Winds were much lighter than day 1 but still switching from left to right as is evident by only [2] 200's being shot at long range, 1 by Dan Makucevich and the other by our Jr. Shooter Allison Schultze during the Dewar. After match 1&2 Allison was clean and leading for the day. She was able to maintain the lead as all competitors struggled at long range, with Ken Potter winning the 100 yd match using Iron sights posting a 398-24. The dreaded meter was won by Mr. Gideon with a 400-26. Once the Dust and Wind settled Ms. Schultze had won the day with a 1593-106. What was more impressive is she usually does not shoot scope and borrowed a rifle to do so this day!

With all firing complete the champion is Paul Gideon, 3180-199, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ken Potter 3176-193, 3<sup>rd</sup> Jeff Perry 3174-204, and the Expert Champion was Allison Schultze 3174-185.
